

MAKE: CRAFTY BIRD FEEDER

It is lovely to see native birds fluttering around in your garden.
Let's make a bird feeder to make them feel more welcome!



YOU WILL NEED: Craft sticks, masking tape, scissors, PVA glue, paint brush or cotton buds, string, twine or wool.



STEP 1: Use craft sticks to make a square. Glue the corners together with PVA glue.



STEP 2: Keep building up the layers, gluing the edges as you go to make a box. Let the glue dry.



STEP 3: To make the base, lay sticks horizontally, side by side. Glue two sticks vertically and one diagonally across. Glue to the base of your box.



STEP 4: Attach perches around the edge of your feeder for your birds to land on. Allow to dry.



STEP 5: Tie string or twine to two opposite corners of your feeder. Hang it in your garden.

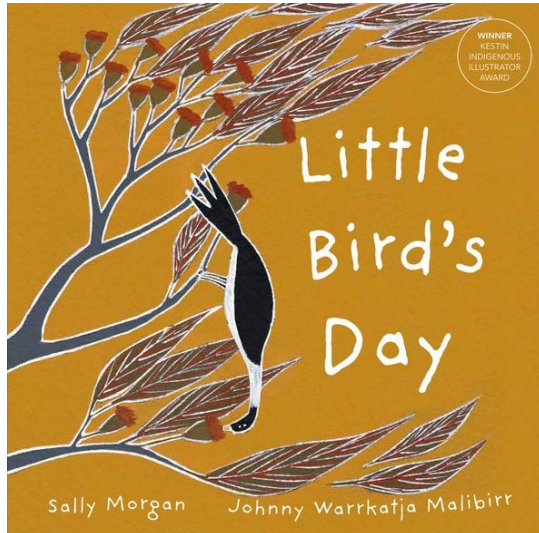
