
MAKE: SILHOUETTE LIGHTHOUSE A MONTH OF HOLIDAY IDEAS



Light up the sky with this colourful activity. Grab a candle, some watercolour paints and brushes to create a silhouette lighthouse sunset scene.



WHAT YOU NEED: White paper, black paper, wax candle, watercolour paints, paintbrush, glue stick.




STEP 2: Take your candle and draw light rays coming from the lighthouse. You won't be able to see them... yet!



STEP 4: Blend the paint colours using water and more paint. Let the paint dry. You should now be able to see the light rays.



STEP 1: Draw and cut out a lighthouse silhouette on black paper. Place the silhouette on your paper. Do not glue down yet.



STEP 3: Remove the silhouette and paint a sunset using the watercolour paints.



STEP 5: Glue the silhouette into place to finish your picture.

MAKE: COLLAGE LIGHTHOUSE A MONTH OF HOLIDAY IDEAS



Create your own lighthouse scene using scraps of colour. Tear, cut and collage your way through this colourful craft.



RESOURCES: White paper, cardboard tube, coloured scrap paper, foil, glue stick, black marker, lead pencil, battery powered tea light (optional).



STEP 2: Draw in a horizon and land. Cover land in glue and start to stick down bits of paper. Overlap the paper so that it covers the area.



STEP 4: Use the cardboard roll to make your lighthouse. Cover in paper and draw on details like windows and doors.



STEP 1: Create collage pieces by roughly ripping up your scrap paper.



STEP 3: Repeat the process with the sky and the sea.




STEP 5: Use foil to create a beam of light and add boats in the sea if you like. Place the tealight on top to the lighthouse to finish!


