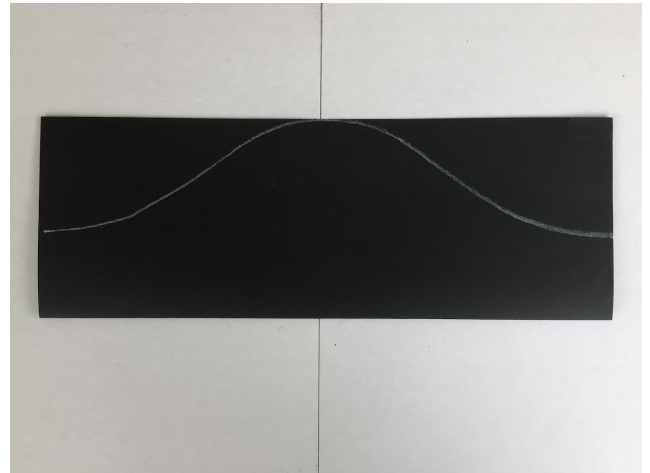

Ahoy there! If ye be lookin' to set sail on the seven seas, then ye be needin' a fierce pirate hat! Follow the instructions below, as best ye can, and you'll be lookin' better than ol' Jolly Roger himself!



WHAT YE NEEDS: A3 black paper (1 sheet), A4 white paper (1 sheet), masking tape, pencil, black marker, glue and scissors.



STEP 1: Fold the A3 sheet of black paper in half long ways and draw the outline of the pirate hat with your pencil.



STEP 2: With the paper folded, cut along your line. Then cut along the fold to make two identical sections. Glue the outside edges of the hat together.



STEP 3: Draw a skull and crossbones onto a piece of white paper with the black marker. Cut it out and glue to the front of the hat.



STEP 4: Cut a strip of black paper and tape across the inside of the hat.



STEP 5: Your fierce pirate hat is ready to wear.

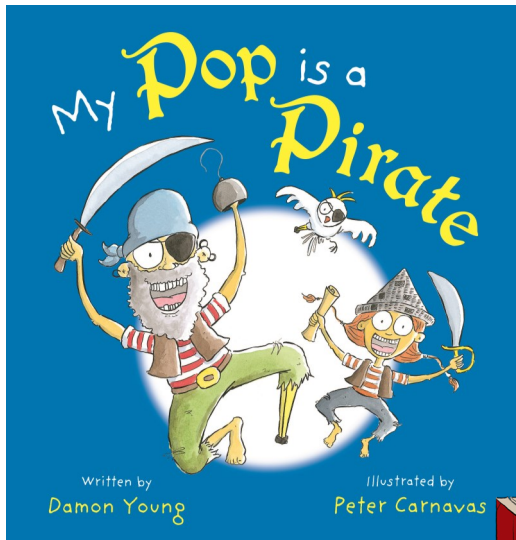

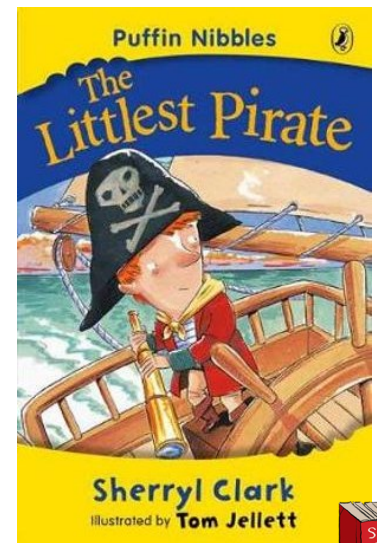

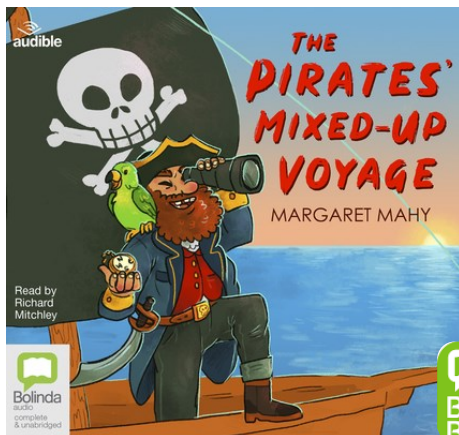
