
## MAKE: SHELF FRIENDS A MONTH OF HOLIDAY IDEAS



Use simple maths concepts and basic craft materials to make a pair of book ends to keep all your books in their place! These are dino-themed, but you can use any pictures you have at home.




**YOU WILL NEED:** Cardboard (an old cereal box will work well), coloured paper, scissors, glue, tape, ruler, pencil, rocks.




STEP 2: Cut 2 strips of cardboard (10cm x 51cm). Measure 15 cm from each end and fold.




STEP 4: Use glue to cover this shape with coloured paper. You don't need to cover one 15cm section of cardboard as this will be the base of your bookend.



**STEP 1:** Cut 2 cardboard squares (15cm x 15cm). Draw a diagonal line and cut to create 4 triangles.




**STEP 3:** Attach the triangles to each cardboard strip with tape.



**STEP 5:** Trim off excess paper with scissors.


**STEP 6:** Create small tabs out of the thin card 13cm by 4cm. Fold these in half. Tape one half of the tab to the short section of the triangles.



**STEP 8:** Before sealing the base of the bookend fill it with small stones (we used corks). Fold and glue the base in place.



**STEP 10:** When both bookends are complete decorate them with images from old books or magazines. They can also be painted or decorated with any craft materials.



**STEP 7:** Begin assembling the bookend by applying glue to the tabs and folding the bookend into shape. Leave the base section for last.



**STEP 9:** Repeat steps two to six and make a matching bookend.




**STEP 11:** Use the bookends to make sure you're books don't go anywhere while you're not reading them!






